# MAIN TEXT: Colossians 3:18-4:1

## WORD OF GOD: What is this text saying?

- 1. Verses 23-24 are the crux of this text. In light of those verses, how do you see the commands for wives, husbands, children, fathers, slaves, and masters?
- 2. Why does this text rub some of us the wrong way...or maybe in the right way?

## **WORSHIP OF GOD:** How does this text affect my relationship with God?

- 1. What does this orderly rules for Christian households teach us about God's relationship with us?
- 2. What do you think your life would look like if you took seriously the command to "work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men" (v.23)?

## **COMMUNITY OF GOD:** How does this text affect our relationships with each other?

- 1. How does this section play itself out in our church communities?
- 2. Why do we often seek to be people-pleasers, rather than serving the Lord Christ?

## **MISSION OF GOD:** What action steps are needed in response to this text?

- 1. Does this slaves and masters section have anything to do with our occupations/work life in our context?
- 2. If so, how do you interpret the exhortation from Paul?
