- 2. SUBMIT TO THE WORD Being honest with yourself, are you more prone to writing off portions of the Bible because they seem bizarre or archaic to you? Do you justify by saying they must not mean that anymore, or have you done your due diligence in study? OR are you more prone towards legalistically taking culturally contextual parts of the scripture and universalizing them too quickly? How do you think you might grow in striking a correct balance?
- 3. **RESPOND IN WORSHIP** Paul addresses men and their temptation towards aggression and women and their temptation towards immodesty when it comes to the church gathering. What temptations do you think we currently bring with us into worship, and how do you think God would have us pursue a pure heart in those areas?
- 4. **LIVE IN COMMUNITY** If verse 12 does indeed still apply as a universal command, what do you think the role of women in the church should be? How can they exercise their gifts, even if there are roles that are restricted for male leadership?
- 5. **JOIN ON MISSION** How does the larger conversation about gender and different/ face
- 6. complementary roles play itself out in the wider world? What do you think a biblical worldview might say to our current cultural moment? How might this affect your witness to your unbelieving friends in your spheres of influence?
