QUESTIONS:

- 1. Have someone in the group summarize the main point/sub points that were preached from Sunday's text. Were there any big things that the Lord revealed to you as you listened and reflected?
- 2. SUBMIT TO THE WORD It seems like the experience of seeing Jesus die (his CHECKMATE moment) caused the women and the Apostles to question whether or not he was actually the messiah. They did not believe...even though he told them it was going to happen. How have you struggled to believe God when you feel like your life is approaching a CHECKMATE of sorts?
- 3. **RESPOND IN WORSHIP** What does knowing the truth of the resurrection of Jesus do in your heart? How has the resurrection changed how you live?
- 4. **LIVE IN COMMUNITY** Notice in the passage how the women are in a group and the Apostles are in a group. They aren't trying to believe in the resurrection all by themselves. What importance is there in doing life with other Christians when it comes to believing some of the more difficult parts of the Bible, like the resurrection?
- 5. **JOIN ON MISSION** If you invited someone to Easter who came, how did they respond to the service? Talk about how your witness to them might be enhanced by your belief in the resurrection.
