QUESTIONS:

- 1. Have someone read the passage out loud.
- 2. Have someone recap the sermon's big idea and main points.
- 3. When have you ever felt like there should be more going on in your spiritual life?
- 4. What things are you prone to put your hope in rather than in the finished work of Jesus Christ?
- 5. Have you ever thought about yourself as God's inheritance? What does that make you feel?
- 6. When you find yourself doubting God's power to overcome you sin, what does that feel like?
- 7. Hope comes from having the Spirit of wisdom, revelation from the knowledge of God, and enlightened eyes of our hearts. How does / can your discipleship group help one another grow in the knowledge of the hope to which we have been called in Christ?
- 8. Paul prays for his Christian brothers and sisters and he encourages them through sharing the specifics of his prayer for them. When you pray for Christian friends and family members, what kind of things do you tend to pray about?

PRAYER:

- 1. Pray that God would give enlightenment to the eyes of our hearts.
 - a. That we would know the hope of his calling.
 - b. That we would know the wealth of his glorious inheritance in the saints.
 - c. That we would know the incredible greatness of his power for us who believe.
