QUESTIONS:

1. Have someone in the group summarize the main point/sub points that were preached from Sunday's text. Were there any big things that the Lord revealed to you as you listened and reflected?
2. **SUBMIT TO THE WORD** Where have you OR are you currently struggling to let the Word of God be your ultimate authority? Are you playing the FEELINGS game or the RELIGION game at all right now?
3. **RESPOND IN WORSHIP** How does the idea that *if you love Jesus you will obey his word* sit with you? Where do you struggle to obey...and therefore, where do you struggle to love?
4. **LIVE IN COMMUNITY** How can having a church family around you help you in submitting to authority and obeying that authority? Can you think of any concrete examples?
5. **JOIN ON MISSION** This text doesn't leave room for the idea of a "nominal" or "non-practicing" Christian. So, how would you confront someone who would say they are a Christian, but have no obedience to Christ in their lives?
