Three foundations to stand on

<u>Two important practices</u>

1. Assume and command/ pray

2. Don't give the devil an opportunity: kick him out and close the door!

Application #2: Stand on the authority of Christ

Memorize Luke 10:17-20

Application #3: Stand on the Truth about God and His ways

Commit yourself to knowing the Word of God and integrating its truth into every nook and cranny of your life. Then write out three practical steps you will take to beef up your knowledge of the Word of God.

Application #4: Stand on the Truth about You

Memorize Ephesians 2:4-7.

Meditate extensively on each word and phrase until its truth about you is the truth you understand, believe and live by.

Using the document "Who I Am" incorporate these Truths of God's Word into the core of your self-image.

Application #5: Assume and command/pray

Begin the practice of exercising the authority of Christ you've been given over the powers of darkness that harass you.

Assume he is there when the guy cuts you off in traffic

As negative impulses rise, command Satan to cease and leave in Jesus name – caveat: you have to really WANT him to; he knows when you're not serious!

Then take the step in the direction the Spirit wants to lead you: towards love, joy, peace, patience, self-control etc. etc.

Application #6: Don't give the devil an opportunity

Take stock of your life before God in a time of prayer

Command the devil to be still and be gone

Ask the Spirit to help you see and understand where you might have been giving space/ place/ room/ opportunity in your life.

Confess to God, renounce to Satan the opportunity you gave him (kick him out), recommit and take the Spirit's hand once more.
