MAIN TEXT: Matthew 28:18-20

WORD OF GOD: What is this text saying?

- 1. Where in the story of Jesus are we (context)?
- 2. Why is Jesus saying these words now to this audience?
- 3. Talk about the three commands: (1) go make disciples, (2) baptize them, (3) teach them to obey. How are these similar and different to how you have understood what God wants from his people?

WORSHIP OF GOD: How does this text affect my relationship with God?

- 1. What does it mean that Jesus has 'all authority in heaven and on earth' (v.18)?
- 2. What is a disciple of Jesus?
- 3. How is it possible that Jesus is 'with you always, to the end of the age' (v.20)?

COMMUNITY OF GOD: How does this text affect our relationships with each other?

- 1. Is this 'great commission' for all believers or is it specifically for certain people and not for others?
- 2. How do we as Christians join forces to fulfill this commission?

MISSION OF GOD: What action steps are needed in response to this text?

- 1. How can you be a part of making disciples practically?
- 2. What would you need to do to 'observe all that I have commanded you' (v.20)?
